



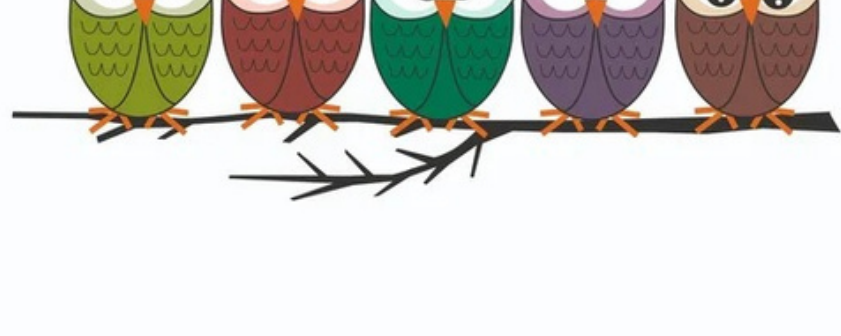

Register here before spots fill up, especially for our March training:

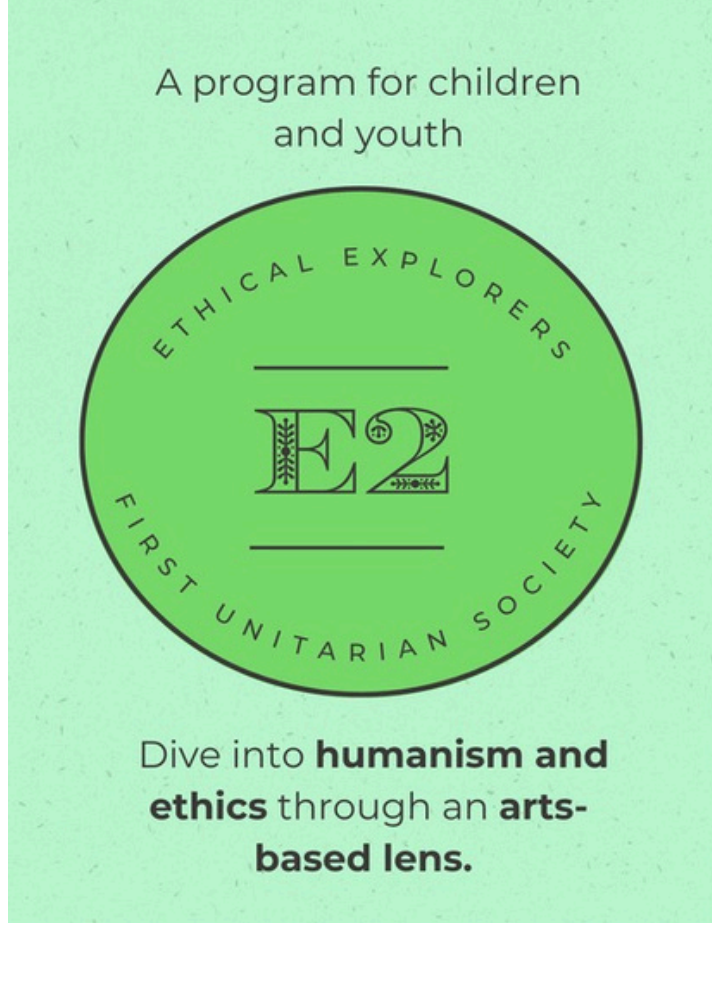

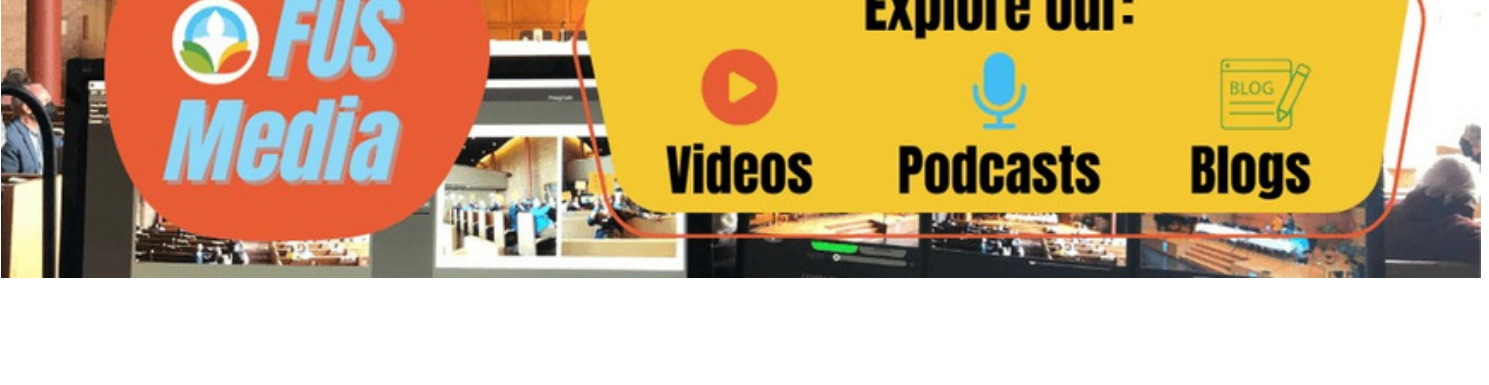


### Interested in supporting and expanding ethical education and family programming at FUS?

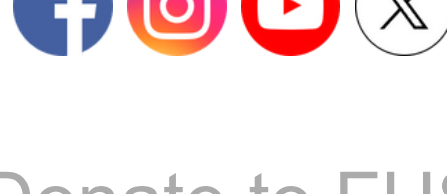
