## CALL FOR VOLUNTEERS!



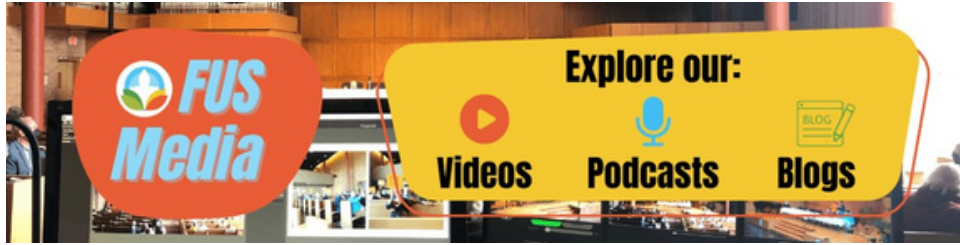
**Interested in supporting and expanding ethical education and family programming at FUS?**
